### General Information

The *ISC Honors Scholarship Program* is a corporation funded program to promote student excellence and achievement and to recognize exceptionally able graduating seniors who show promise of continued excellence. Four scholarships will be awarded in Wyoming for the 2009-2010 school year. These \$1,500 scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit for the first year of study at an institution of higher education located in Wyoming, Colorado, Utah, Idaho, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota or Nebraska. Additionally, it is ISC's intention to award a student from each quadrant of the State of Wyoming. Awards are subject to the availability of ISC Corporate funding and may be received for up to a total of four years.

### Eligibility Requirements

- 1) Applicant must be a 2010 graduate of a Wyoming public or private secondary school or have the equivalent of a certificate of graduation recognized by the state.
- 2) Applicant must have been accepted for enrollment at an institution of higher education for the fall of 2010. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to which institution they plan to attend. **Scholarships cannot be awarded for use at a military service academy.** A copy of the letter of acceptance must be included with the application.
- 3) Applicant must have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and show promise of continued academic excellence.
- 4) Applicant must have a minimum high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.80 that is unweighted on a 4.0 scale.
- 5) Scholarship recipients must attend an institution of higher education on a full-time basis as defined by that institution, starting in the fall, 2010. Institution must be in WY, CO, UT, ID, MT, ND, SD or NE.
- 6) Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or national of the United States or have evidence from the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service that he or she is a permanent resident or is in the United States for other than a temporary purpose, **and** be a Wyoming resident even though he/she lives outside the State, e.g. military.
- 7) Financial need is not a factor in the selection process.

### Application Procedure

- 1) Complete all sections of this application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Refer to the final checklist to be sure all materials are included before mailing.
- 2) The selection panel will not review any additional information such as letters of recommendation, photographs, or any other extra documents. Please do not include these items in the application packet.
- 3) Application and all attachments must be on plain white paper and stapled or clipped in the upper left hand corner. **DO NOT** submit the application packet in a binder or report cover.
